Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we continue into second term, I would like to reiterate the necessary procedures when dropping off and picking up your child. Please review and take note of the following information.

-We ask parents/guardians who accompany their children to school to continue to park their cars in a safe location. **Do not park in the designated** <u>Accessible Parking Spaces</u>. Accessible Parking Spaces are reserved for visitors with disabilities/mobility issues and who hold accessible parking permits. Please do not park/temporarily park in these designated parking spots.

-Regardless if the pylons are in place/not, vehicles are <u>not</u> permitted inside the bus loop at <u>any time - (BUS</u> <u>LOOP located at front of main doors)</u>. Vehicles must not enter the NO ENTRY side of the bus loop to access the main doors for late entry.

-Parents who are parking and then walking their child/children to the designated yard/area are advised to use the sidewalk/adjacent pathways instead of cutting across the drive through/'kiss n' ride lane or the parking lot (this is extremely dangerous).

-For those families that are **crossing La Rocca Avenue**, please use the Crosswalk and wait for the Crossing Guard. Using a crosswalk greatly reduces the chances of an accident compared to crossing at an unmarked location.

-Parents/guardians/visitors dropping off their child/ren are asked to either **walk** their child to school, **park** along the permitted adjacent routes/staff parking and walk their child/ren to the designated yard/area or to the main doors (during inclement weather days)

-Parents/Guardians/visitors/pets are not permitted on school grounds. All adults picking up and/or dropping off are to remain behind the fenced areas at all times. – Do not enter the primary/junior/intermediate play areas. Should you require any assistance, please speak to the teacher on duty. Student safety is our number one priority.

-Ensure that you use the drive through lanes for quick pick up/drop off (do not park for extended periods).

- Be vigilant and careful when navigating through our parking lot at ALL times and when driving, please STOP at the designated STOP signs.

Tips for pedestrians of all ages

- Walk young children to school.
- Encourage children to always obey the crossing guards.
- Walk, don't run, when crossing the street.
- Pay attention to vehicular traffic while walking along or crossing roads.
- Turn ear buds off and do not look down at phones when crossing intersections.

- Obey all traffic rules and signals.
- Ensure you are visible to drivers and cyclists, and make eye contact once they have stopped before crossing.
- Cross at designated crosswalks, crossovers or controlled intersections.
- Be mindful of slippery conditions on sidewalks and roadways.

Tips for drivers and cyclists

- Reduce speed in school zones, especially when slippery conditions are present, and be ready to stop at all times.
- Ensure to give yourself enough time to get to your destination.
- Expect the unexpected. Children may cross the street at the wrong place, run into traffic or ride a bike in front of a vehicle without warning.
- Stop for school buses and be aware of children running in front of or behind buses.
- Avoid U-turns in school zones.
- Do not pass other vehicles in a school zone.
- Obey the rules of the road, including posted speed limits.
- Abide by all parking and traffic regulations in school zones.
- Obey crossing guard signals and yield to pedestrians.
- Pay attention to the surroundings. Watch for and yield the whole roadway to pedestrians when approaching a pedestrian crossover. Failing to do so may result in fines of up to \$1,000 and four demerit points.
- Avoid distraction within the vehicle and ensure children are secured in a correctly installed child restraint seat.
- Ensure children exit by the passenger side of the vehicle.
- Keep fire routes and bus zones clear.
- Leave nine metres (or 29 feet) between the car and the crosswalks and/or stop signs when parking. Parking too close to these locations makes it difficult to see children when crossing the road.
- Avoid double parking in school zones.
- Watch for signs indicating "No Stopping" and "No Parking."
- Stay back 0.6 metres (or two feet) from private driveways to avoid upsetting residents.
- When cycling or using a micro mobility device, dismount before crossing the street(or the yellow painted in the school parking lot) always dismount before crossing!

York Regional Police and City of Vaughan Bylaw Officers will provide increased presence around peak bell times where possible.

Our Community Members are Asked to Report Unlawful/Aggressive Driving:
